U očekivano vreme prenosa pošiljke ne ulazi:

- vreme zadržavanja pošiljke na carinama
- praznici koji se praznuju neradno kako kod prijemnog tako i kod dostavnog operatora

Adresovanje:

Adresa primaoca - poštanski fah - nije dozvoljeno

Masa:

Maksimalna dozvoljena masa je 30 kg

Dimenzije:

Maksimalne dimenzije paketa su: zbir dužine i obima paketa na najširem mestu poprečno može biti najviše 3000 mm, s tim da najveća dimenzija ne sme prelaziti 1500 mm.

Sadržina:

Spisak opšte zabranjenih predmeta:

- opojne droge i psihotropne materije
- eksplozivne, zapaljive ili druge opasne materije kao i radioaktivni materijali
- žive životinje
- sablažnjivi i nemoralni predmeti i materijali
- falsifikovani predmeti i piraterijski materijal
- eksplozivne naprave, municija ili njihove kopije
- kovani novac, banknote, efektivna ili bilo kakve hartije od vrednosti naplative donosiocu, putnički čekovi, platina, zlato ili srebro, drago kamenje, nakit ili druge dragocenosti
- kvarljive biološke supstance

- zarazne materije
- dokumenta koja imaju karakter aktuelne i lične prepiske, razmenjene između lica koja nisu pošiljalac ili primalac
- predmeti koji po prirodi ili pakovanju mogu biti opasni za zaposlene i koji mogu oštetiti druge pošiljke ili poštansku opremu
- predmeti čiji je prenos zabranjen propisima Republike Srbije, kao i predmeti čiji je uvoz ili promet zabranjen u određenoj zemlji

In common with other major delivery companies, there are certain goods and substances that we cannot accept and must not be sent by customers. This is to comply with national and international regulations governing the carriage of mail, to protect the health, safety and wellbeing of our employees, customers and the general public. You are responsible for checking whether or not an item is prohibited or restricted.

What are the prohibitions?

Unless specifically permitted, we cannot carry dangerous goods. ‘Dangerous goods’ are articles or substances which are capable of posing a risk to health, safety, property or the environment. Existing regulations prohibit sending the majority of dangerous goods in the mail. We also prohibit other items for legal reasons, or where in our opinion they may be harmful or dangerous to our customers or employees.

Section 14 of the EU format SDS indicates that a product is classified as dangerous goods by the presence of a four digit ‘UN’ number.

Products bearing the following consumer warning markings are also classified as dangerous goods.

Money: bankers drafts, current bank notes, currency notes or coins, postal orders, cheques or dividend warrants; bearer

securities including share warrants, scrips, or subscription certificates, bonds or relative coupons, unfranked postage

stamps, or revenue stamps, (except a revenue stamp embossed or impressed on an instrument which has been executed);

coupons, vouchers, tokens, lottery tickets, scratch cards or similar items which can be exchanged themselves or with any

other item for money, goods or services; national insurance stamps; all tickets, including travel and events. Out of

circulation coins (not made of Silver or Gold) are classed as Collectables.

International Export Licences and International Packaging

Items requiring Parcelforce Worldwide to obtain any special licence or permit for transportation, importation or exportation;

or consignments with a declared value for customs in excess of that permitted for the particular destination should not be

sent on any international service.
